East Wendham.

Oct 26 1875

Dear Fall.

We had erecting yesterday in the church for the first time since it was fixed, it looks splendid, there is quite a large aisle which adds a good deal to the looks on the outside, I think the church is about 20 ft longer than it was, the ceiling is plastered new & the walls are papered the wood work is painted white, the ~~the~~ choir is fixed off in the south east corner the floor is raised about a foot & with a black walnut railing all around it, the pulpit & choir are carpeted with red & black carpet & the pews are covered with a kind of mulling, there are two chandeliers in the ~~center~~ center with four lamps on each, & brackets with 2 lamps on each behind the pulpit, the pulpit is covered with with heavy red cloth trimmed with fringe & tassels. it was crowded to overflowing yesterday.
